Milton C. Larry, formerly of 1424 W street, N.W., Washington, D. C., has returned to the European Theater of Operations after being home on rotation leave, to serve the armed forces as an American Red Cross program director. Larry is one of 270 Negroes now serving overseas with the Red Cross. He was in the first group of Negro Red Cross workers assigned to foreign posts in 1942.
