<b>Abstract</b>	George B. Murphy, Jr. was born into the prominent and prosperous family that built the <i>Afro-American</i> newspaper and went on to fight for anti-racist and anti-colonialist causes throughout his life. His collection contains subject files and correspondence regarding people and organizations he was involved with.

## Biographical/Historical note

---

George B. Murphy, Jr. was born into the prominent and prosperous family that built the *Afro-American* newspaper. Murphy was a crucial component to almost every social and political movement in Black history during his life time, locally, nationally and internationally. He worked with the NCAAP, Community Party, Black artists and scholars, and his family's newspaper business. From the early 1920s until his death, Murphy was an activist who pushed for racial and social justice world-wide. His grandfather was John H. Murphy, the founder of the Baltimore Afro American and the Afro-American Co., Inc. The newspaper was a weekly publication that promoted race pride, exposed racism in the US, and printed articles and reports by contemporary cultural critics and scholars. Murphy graduated from Douglass High School in D.C. in 1922, and earned his undergraduate degree from Dickinson College in 1926. After college, he taught at Allen University in South Carolina before returning to Baltimore to serve as editor of the Afro-American in the late 1920s. He worked for the family newspaper until the 1930s when he moved to D.C. to become the Editor-in-Chief of the Washington Afro-American from the 1940s-1950s. Murphy was known nation-wide as a staunch activist, working fervently in the NAACP. He later joined the National Negro Congress in order to work against labor discrimination and poverty. Murphy was very much a part of the community of African Americans who embraced Communist ideals. He became a member of the National Council of America-Soviet Friendship. He published booklets on life in Moscow, and led many trips to Russia for African Americans. He worked with Paul Robeson and his wife Eslanda in Black-Russian relationship organizations. He served in the army during WWII. After his service, he continued to tour the Philippines recruiting Black veterans to join the United Negro and Allied Veterans Organization, a union fighting against Black veterans being lynched and discriminated against. He founded the Hands Across the World Friendship Society and was a member of the National Association for the Study of Afro-American Life and History. He was an original signer of the "We Charge Genocide" a petition authored and delivered to the UN by Paul Robeson. Later in his life, he joined the National Alliance Against Racist and Political Repression and had served on the Free Angela Davis Committee. Murphy spent his life forming friendships with other activists and scholars including W.E.B. DuBois, Shirley Graham, Thurgood Marshal, Paul Robeson and Benjamin Davis. He was member of Alpha Phi Alpha fraternity.
